OVERVIEW:

Under general direction of the Fire Marshal to gain compliance with and enforce all City laws, codes, and ordinances related to fire protection, performs complex fire inspection and enforcement work including specialized inspections. Develops inspection procedures and programs promoting awareness and responsibility toward fire prevention and to assure the application of a high level of fire protection technology in the community.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The listed examples of work are not intended to be all-inclusive. They may be modified with additions, deletions, or changes as necessary.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities

- Inspects a variety of building to determine safety and compliance with fire codes and other City ordinances.
- Conducts inspections of construction projects to ensure compliance with adopted fire codes, national standards, and approved construction plans.
- Conducts specialized process, system, and occupancy inspections.
- Performs inspections; issues permits, warnings and order notices; and performs follow-up compliance and enforcement work in accordance with policies and procedures.
- Cites deficiencies and code violations to identify hazards and provides guidance to obtain compliance.
- Researches, documents, and verifies that code compliances are met, promotes business owners', contractor's and the general public's awareness and responsibility toward fire prevention.
- Responds to and resolves complaints from internal and external customers.
- Assists in development and delivery of in-service training programs, maintains records of building and permit inspections to document violations, issues permits for special processes including hazardous materials and develops procedures to enforce proper usage and control.
- Participates in public safety efforts of other agencies, promotes communication with the general public and with peers regarding fire suppression issues.
- Prepares periodic reports, issues summons, testifies or serves as an expert witness in Municipal Court.

Other Duties & Responsibilities

Performs other duties as assigned and required.

PREPARATION AND TRAINING:

Education: Associates Degree (preferred) in Fire Science, Construction Management, Building Construction, Plan Review or a degree in other related field

Work Experience: Experience in firefighting required, fire safety inspection or fire code related building inspections; including a minimum of 12 months as a fire inspector

Required Certifications and/or Licensures:

- International Code Council (ICC) Certification as an International Fire Code Inspector I
- Fire Inspector 1
- Colorado Hazardous Materials Operations Certification

Required Driver's License: Valid Colorado driver's license with an acceptable driving record

An equivalent combination of education, training and relevant job experience may be substituted.
