## Job Description

Buffalo Creek, CO - Seasonal, Full-time Firefighter/EMT & Firefighter/Paramedic Temporary

This is for a Seasonal full-time position, approximately May—September, with North Fork Fire Protection District located in Buffalo Creek, CO . Under immediate supervision, responds to fire emergency calls, assists in wildland suppression, participates in fire prevention and education, pre-suppression activities to include but not limited to equipment and facility maintenance.

Pay: Firefighter/EMT \$15.00—\$18.00 per hour Depending on Experience and Certifications

Firefighter/Paramedic \$17.00—\$20.00 per hour Depending on Experience and Certifications

### Examples of Duties:

***This lists the major duties and requirements of the job and is not all-inclusive. Incumbent (s) may be expected to perform job-related duties other than those contained in this document and may be required to have specific job-related knowledge and skills.***

- Perform firefighting work, including preventing, combating and extinguishing fires to protect lives, property and environment.
- Assists in wildland fire operations; lays hoses and directs hose streams; constructs fire control lines; operates power tools and pumps; raises and climbs ladders; uses fire extinguishers; performs overhaul and salvage work in order to preserve lives, property and resources related to wildland and urban interface firefighting.
- Participates in pre suppression activities include: conduct inspections of fire department equipment; performs daily clean-up and maintenance of equipment, buildings and vehicles; checks inventory and supplies..
- Provides emergency medical care within scope of practice

### Qualifications: (minimum)

- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- A valid driver's license with an acceptable driving record
- Current CO EMT-B and CPR or Current CO EMT-P depending on position applying for

### Preferred:

- Current Wildland Red Card or previous NWCG S-130/S-190 ( *This position participates in wildland firefighting activities. Based on the type of work performed, TAKING and PASSING the WCT at the ARDUOUS level is a "condition of employment." The Arduous fitness (Pack) Test consists of a three (3) mile hike, within forty-five (45) minutes, while carrying a forty-five (45) pound pack. )*
- Structural FF1 and Hazmat Ops Certifications
