The Platte Valley Fire Protection District is looking for intelligent, ambitious, motivated, people to join our team as Reserve Firefighters (volunteer). We are a single station combination department that provides service to 220 square miles of Northern Colorado. As an all hazards department we cover residential, commercial, and wildland fires, technical rescue including confined space, trench, high and low rope rescue, hazmat, swift water and dive rescue operations. Our recently finished training center includes a three two story Class-A burn building, dedicated trench and confined space props, oil and natural gas props, search maze, as well as areas for high and low angle rope rescue training. We partner with UC Health who has a full-time crew and ambulance at our station.

- 18 years of age at the time of testing
- High school diploma or GED
- Valid State of Colorado driver's license

- Current National Testing Network (NTN) test
- Able to pass a fit for duty test
