

Colorado Division of Fire Prevention and Control and the North Area Training Chiefs are hosting:

Incident Safety Officer February 20-22, 2019 0800-1700 Hrs.

This course is designed for fire officers who have safety officer responsibilities at emergency operation situations. The Incident Safety Officer course satisfies the requirements of the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA 1521), and provides the tools necessary to obtain certification through the Colorado Division of Fire Prevention and Control. Candidates will attend lecture and participate in group exercises to provide a solid foundation of knowledge to act as the ISO at an incident. The course covers ISO responsibilities at all-hazards types of situations. Candidates will be developing a Job Performance Requirement (JPR) portfolio on-site and are expected to complete additional JPRs outside of the class.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Students will be contacted 30 days prior to the start of class with instructions for accessing the online course content and completing 3 pre-course JPRs. The students will need to complete 3 JPRs after the conclusion of the class. Directions for the post-course JPRs will be provided during class.

COST: \$100

LUNCH: Students are responsible for lunch. Students will have an hour for lunch each day.
