This 16-hour course will be facilitated by South Metro Fire Rescue's Todd Hennessy and Joe Sims. In addition to the expectations covered in the 8th edition of Fire and Emergency Services Instructor (IFSTA), this course will go more in depth on the Role of the Instructor, the Psychology of Learning, Public Speaking, and Instructional Delivery.

Students are required to read the IFSTA Fire and Emergency Services Instructor book (8th or 9th Edition) - Chapters 1 thru 9 and pass the Pre-Course Self-Assessments **prior to class!**

The student must attend both days to obtain a certificate of completion.

This class will count as the initial Instructor Methodology course as set forth by the Colorado Division of Fire Safety for the Fire Instructor I level.

This class **does not** provide a State of Colorado Division of Fire Safety written or practical exam for Instructor I. The class does provide the opportunity to meet other instructors in the emergency service field, and create lessons plans.
