This exempt, full time position is responsible for developing and managing a comprehensive, effective fire prevention staff and program. The position is responsible for overseeing such programs as construction and code enforcement inspections, community wildfire protection plans, plan review and public education.

The candidate for Fire Marshal must have a minimum of an Associate Degree in Fire Science Technology or a combination of education and expertise that provides the required knowledge for the position, DOD and/or college equivalent certification will be accepted. Current ICC certification as Fire Inspector II or higher, and a minimum five (5) years of fire prevention related experience. Current ICC certification as Fire Plans Examiner. Five (5) years field experience as a Firefighter. Fire investigations experience including wildland fire investigations.

The candidate will have or be able to obtain a Colorado driver's license and CPR certification.

The successful candidate will be required to authorize and pass a thorough background investigation and a physical examination (including drug screen).
