To be considered a Chief Level Officer, the applicant must have served or be serving in that capacity. As per Division of Fire Prevention and Control guidelines, a Chief Officer is defined as follows:

- Chief/CEO of the Department
- Chief Officer or equivalent who are heads of major bureaus or divisions within a fire department/organization: e.g., suppression, prevention, training, etc.
- Chief Officer or equivalent who command multi-company or multi-station operations on the emergency scene or who may command a greater alarm incident.
