Welcome and Advisory Board Business – Jarrod Hindman

- Meeting was called to order at 1:34 PM by Jarrod Hindman who introduced himself and the new individuals to the Board.

 - The rest of the Board members and staff then introduced themselves.
- Meeting Notes were approved from the February 7, 2017, meeting as written.
- Chris Harms thanked George Welsh for his time as the Board Chair and Jarrod Hindman for taking over as Board Chair. She also thanked Collette Hohnbaum for her service and help to the Center.
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CSSRC Activities - CSSRC Staff

- Gay & Lesbian Fund for Colorado – Rural School Safety Summits
 - Ms. Harms recapped the past work done through the Center with the Gill Grant and informed the Board that there were still funds left over that we were requested to utilize. She provided the schedule for the Rural Safety Summits that would be held in Durango, Grand Junction and La Junta and the plan to involve students in the events.
- Juvenile Justice & Delinquency Prevention – DCJ Grant
 - Ms. Harms discussed the previous work done with this grant and the plans for the upcoming Restorative Practice workshops to be completed with the remaining grant funds.
- SEM Grant
 - Ms. Harms informed the Board that we were granted a no-cost extension and were looking into utilizing the funds for additional trainings.

- The Board was reminded about the upcoming IHE conference in June; the Child Sexual Abuse Prevention and Intervention Symposium in September; and the School Safety Summit that will take place October 18th and 19th in collaboration with the Center for the Study and Prevention of Violence (CSPV) and Safe2Tell.

2:00 – 2:15 Legislative Update –Margaret Ochoa for Gabby Reed, CDPS Legislative Liaison

- Sexting:
 - Margaret Ochoa recapped the two different sexting bills that have been introduced and the scope of charges. At this time the Center has not taken a position on either bill yet. Mrs. Ochoa discussed the differences between the two bills including final charges, factors that affect the charges, and more. Mr. Welsh also provided his standing on the bills and his reasoning.
- HB 1204 ? **Not much info avail for this section**
- SB 005 Handgun Safety Training for School
 - This passed the Senate second reading in February.
 - Was held indefinitely by the Hous.

Youth Engaged in School Safety (YES²) – Anna Gisetti & Margaret Ochoa

- The members of Yes² introduced themselves.
- Videos that the youth completed were shown individually, the student would then explain why they chose to create their video on that specific subject and what middle school they were going to reach out to.
- The youth then took individual questions from the Board related to their videos and experiences.

3:00 – 3:30 Advisory Board Updates – Advisory Board and Guests

- Ms. Lammers provided an update regarding the CASB Board of Education based on the meeting held in December of 2016. There was a new director of annual convention. The National Association meeting was held in Denver a few weeks ago and Ms. Lammers informed the Board that this is her last year on the CASB Board and School Board.
- Ms. Odom discussed the annual PTA Convention at the end of the month with several workshops including Healthy Kids Colorado Survey, One Colorado Safe School project, Marijuana Awareness, crisis line, and informed the Board that Mr. Welsh will be giving a workshop on sexting and potentially cyberbullying.
- Mr. Collis reminded the Board of the upcoming CASRO Conference that will be held on June 28, 29, and 30th in Breckenridge, Colorado. Some of the topics will include Chasing the Dragon, debrief training on the Jessica Ridgeway incident, Jermaine Galloway will be presenting on High in Plain Sight, Social Media, and more.
