Dr. Sroka received the Outstanding School Health Educator Award from the American School Health Association, was selected the Walt Disney Outstanding Health Teacher of the Year, and was inducted into the National Teachers Hall of Fame.

Phil Chalmers-Teen Killers

has interviewed over 200 teen killers and school shooters, along with numerous serial killers, mass murderers, and sexual predators.
