



DPS' Story - Big Picture

- Over the past six years, decreased the use of OSS by 62%, while student population increased by over 7,000
- In SY 2012-13, 4th lowest in expulsion rates for the 20 largest Colorado school districts
- Have a trained Restorative Approach staff in all elementary schools and high schools
- In SY 2012-13, eliminated the contribution of racial bias in district's expulsion process and expulsion decisions
- Despite, this, consistent racial disparities continue









 - Implicit Bias Training

What can you do to address disparities in student discipline

- Educate yourself to the scope of the issue nationally
- Google and take the Implicit Bias test and ask your colleagues to do the same.
- Forge stakeholder groups
- Create a board policy that reinforces therapeutic and restorative approaches over punishment.
- Develop systems and checks to ensure that racial bias does not impact your discipline process
- Focus your support on the classroom level. This is likely where the greatest amount of discretion that leads to disparities occurs
- Implement promising strategies, like Restorative Approaches, that balance teacher needs for structure with student needs for fairness.
