Morning: Dr. Nicoletti, PhD

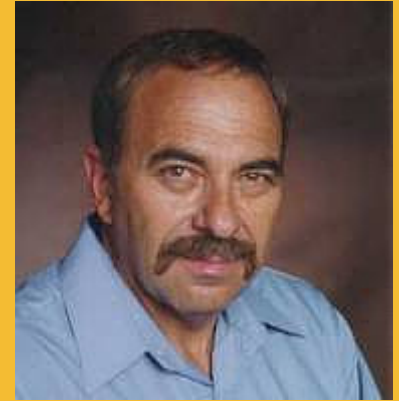
Dr. Nicoletti will analyze the latest school attacks discussing insider vs. outsider threats and how schools can minimize vulnerabilities. He will also discuss how to thoughtfully consider student mental health issues in these latest conversations.

Morning: Ellen Campbell

Ellen Campbell is a team leader at the U.S. Department of Education's Family Policy Compliance Office, which administers the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA). Ellen will speak on the FERPA privacy requirements that relate to safe schools and sharing information on at-risk students.

John Nicoletti, PhD, ABPP received this Ph.D. in Counseling Psychology from Colorado State University in 1972. He has since established himself as a national expert in police psychology, violence risk assessment, workplace and school violence prevention, as well as crisis intervention and trauma recovery. Dr. Nicoletti has been asked to take part in several high profile investigations, including Columbine High School and Virginia Tech shootings.
