

## ASIST – Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training for School Staff June 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> in Golden, Colorado

A number of Colorado schools are training their mental health professionals in ASIST to support their conducting suicide assessments in their buildings

The Colorado School Safety Resource Center is pleased to be offering a two-day training in ASIST on Tuesday and Wednesday, June 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> 2017 at the Jefferson County Courthouse.

This training provides practical training for caregivers seeking to prevent the immediate risk of suicide and to help a person at risk stay safe and seek further help. Evaluations have shown that the workshop increases caregiver's knowledge and confidence to respond to a person at risk of suicide, those interventions skills are retained over time and that they are put to use to save lives.

Time: The workshop will run from 8:00 AM until 4:00 PM on June 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>. You must

attend the entire workshop to be certified in ASIST 11.

**Location:** Jefferson County Court House, 100 Jefferson County Parkway, Golden, CO 80401

**Cost:** \$80/for the two days to cover the cost of materials and lunch both days.

**Registration:** The workshop is limited to 15 participants on a first -come, first-served basis.
