Assess the threats and hazards.</li> <li>◆ Assess the threats and hazards identified using a rubric developed by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).</li> <li>◆ Develop goals and objectives for the three highest priority risks.</li> <li>◆ Identify critical functions common to all goals and objectives.</li> <li>◆ Identify courses of action to meet all goals and objectives.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Use the information collected in the first workshop to begin writing the School/District Emergency Operations Plan (EOP).</li> <li>◆ Based on the guidance found in the "Guide for Developing High Quality School Emergency Operations Plans."</li> <li>◆ Includes the Basic Plan, Functional Annexes and Threat/Hazard Annexes.</li> <li>◆ Gain knowledge to complete the School/District EOP at the end of this workshop (team will have access to a variety of tools, including Colorado-specific tools, in both hard copy and electronic versions).</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Learn how to take your knowledge back to your district.</li> <li>◆ Write and plan Table Top Exercises (TTX).</li> <li>◆ Make exercises come to life!</li> <li>◆ Access tools and resources to make this job easier.</li> <li>◆ Finalize your EOP.</li> </ul>

During each workshop we will focus on gaining knowledge, not just filling in the blanks. In order to do this the instructors will use selected portions of FEMA's Multi-Hazard Emergency Planning for Schools coursework along with Colorado specific tools and a set of tools developed by the REMS TA Center. It is vital that members of each team have taken these required FEMA courses before the first workshop: IS 100SCa for all members and IS 100SCa, IS 700, and IS 362.a for the team leader.
