Death</li> <li>2. serious bodily injury</li> <li>3. officer discharge of a firearm in the direction of a person (does not include less-lethal weapons).</li> </ol>	<p>Law enforcement contacts:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. An in-person interaction with an individual for the purpose of enforcing the law or investigating possible violations of the law</li> </ol> <p>Use of force:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>2. All use of force that results in death or serious bodily injury or that involves the use (unholstering, brandishing, discharging) of a weapon (firearm, long gun, Taser, baton, nunchucks, or projectile weapon).</li> </ol>
