Pursuant to HB 21-1060 all agencies that can certify a U-Visa application must report information regarding applications, approvals, and denials. Certifying agencies include law enforcement, local district/county/city attorneys, courts, Attorney General, any agency responsible for detection or investigation of criminal activity, or entities with criminal detection or investigative jurisdiction, which may include human services, social services, or the department of labor and employment.

## July 1, 2022 onward

- (1) A certifying agency shall process and either sign or decline to sign a certification form within *ninety days* after receipt of a request, except in cases where 4 applies.
- (2) A certifying agency shall process and either sign or decline to sign a certification form within thirty days after receipt of a request if:
- (a) The requestor provides documentation that he or she is in federal immigration removal proceedings; or



requestor would become ineligible for U nonimmigrant status by virtue of age within sixty business days after the date that the certifying official receives the certification form request.
