

Initial LSI Risk Level of Residential Diversion Clients















LSI Risk Level of Residential Diversion Clients By TxRW Level and Termination Reason for Fiscal Year 2020







December 2021 - August 2022

- Dec 22, 2021: denial reason expansion
- 5175 total *Reasons* 
  - #1 Other (20%)
  - #2 Disciplinary History (13%)
  - #3 Pattern of Community Supervision Failure (11%)
    - 15% of Other reference Behavior History or Conduct
- If unsuccessful and with a felony conviction, may compromise a future chance at community corrections as Diversion/Direct Sentence
