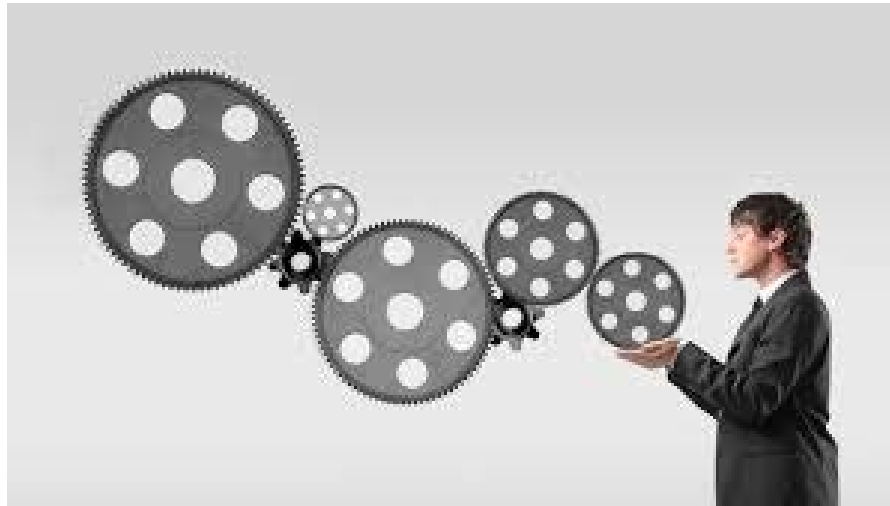
# Crossover Youth Practice Model (CYPM)

- Reduce the length of stay in out of home care.

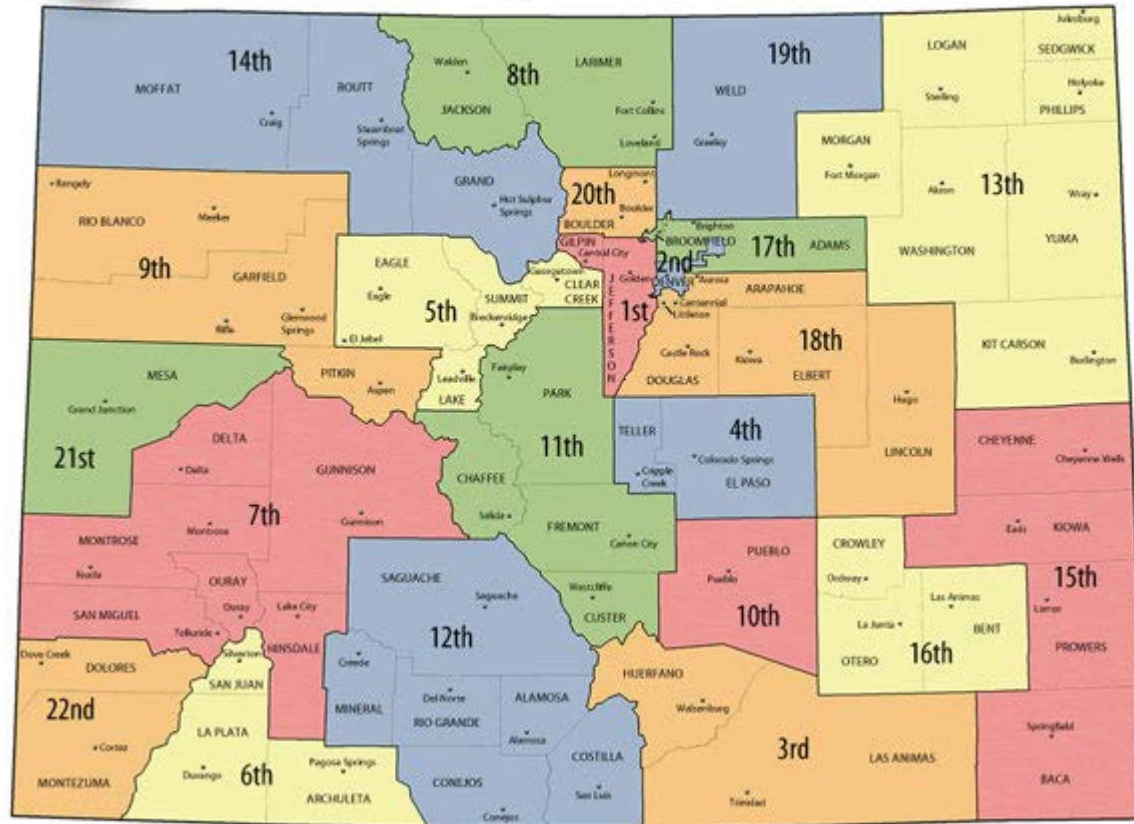
