FY08-DF #2 Expungement following juvenile system conviction subsequent to an initial direct file

Recommendation FY08-DF #2

Clarify that a juvenile conviction can be sealed following adjudication as a juvenile, although charges were initially filed in adult court (direct file).

Discussion

This clarification allows for the sealing of records in cases where a juvenile receives a sentence in the juvenile system (i.e., an adjudication) in the specific circumstance where the filing was originally made in the adult system (direct file).
