**Discussion on Habitual Offender** 

### A. The 4 types of habitual charges:

### 1. 18-1.3-801(1) Super Life

a. Conviction of any class 1 or 2 felony, or a class 3 felony which is a crime of violence with two prior convictions for any class 1 or 2 felony or a class 3 crime of violence. Sentence shall be life with possibility of parole after 40 years.

### 2.18-1.3-801(1.5) <u>Little</u>

a. Conviction of class 1, 2, 3, 4, or 5 felony, with 2 prior felonies within 10 years of commission of underlying felony. Sentence shall be 3 times the maximum presumptive.

### 3.18-1.3-801(2) Big

a. Conviction for any class felony with 3 prior felony convictions.
Sentence shall be 4 times the maximum presumptive.

### 4.18-1.3-801(2.5) Life

a. Conviction for a crime of violence with prior conviction under 18-1.3-801(2) (big bitch). Sentence shall be life with possibility of parole after 40 years.
