# Community Corrections Task Force

## 2014 Retreat Assignments and Status

### Community and Community Boards

- Multiple recommendations are in progress regarding board membership and training.
- Goals include providing consistent training across boards, maintain a minimum membership on all boards, and providing boards with consistent and reliable information about offenders.

# Community Corrections Task Force

## 2014 Retreat Assignments and Status

### Populations Served by Community Corrections

- Multiple recommendations are in progress to design an infrastructure where low risk/high stakes offenders and very high risk (but community-appropriate) offenders can be placed and effectively managed in the community corrections system.
- There has been discussion about recommending changes to the Community Corrections Standards that would allow for more flexibility when managing low-, medium-, and high-risk clients. Statutory limitations will need to be identified.

# Community Corrections Task Force

## 2014 Retreat Assignments and Status

### Referral Process

- Multiple recommendations are in progress to review, develop and design a referral process that considers factors that are consistent with EBP for intervening with offenders and measure of offender readiness or preparation for release as it pertains to Transition clients.
- The process for Diversion clients to be addressed at a later time.

## 2014 Retreat Assignments and Status

### Sex Offense Issues: Determinate F4 and Lifetime Supervision

- The Sex Offense Working Group has met four times since the Commission's directive in March to finalize work in these two areas.
- At this stage it appears the working group *may* come to a consensus on a recommendation regarding early termination from lifetime supervision for offenders who are severely physically incapacitated.
- The group is split on whether there is a need to create a Determinate F4.

## 2014 Retreat Assignments and Status

### Sex Offense Issues: Determinate F4 and Lifetime Supervision

- The Sex Offense Working Group has one more meeting scheduled for August 13<sup>th</sup> to finalize discussion on both issues and plan its presentation of findings to the Comprehensive Sentencing Task Force.
- The Comprehensive Sentencing Task Force is scheduled to meet September 3<sup>rd</sup> to review the findings from the Sex Offense Working Group.
