



**FY2008 RECOMMENDATION/FY08-DF02 EXPUNGEMENT FOLLOWING
JUVENILE SYSTEM CONVICTION SUBSEQUENT TO AN INITIAL DIRECT FILE**

Actions/Updates

Action on this recommendation was completed with the passage of House Bill 2009 - 1044.

Description

Clarify that a juvenile conviction can be sealed following adjudication as a juvenile, although charges were initially filed in adult court (direct file).

Agencies Responsible

Discussion

This clarification allows for the sealing of records in cases where a juvenile receives a sentence in the juvenile system (i.e., an adjudication) in the specific circumstance where the filing was originally made in the adult system (direct file).
