FY2010 RECOMMENDATION/FY10-D14 NON-ALCOHOL RELATED TRAFFIC OFFENSES AND HTO

Status: Implementation Unknown

Actions/Updates

2023 UPDATE (JUNE)

During the FY 2023 Legislative Session, Senate Bill 2023-158 to reauthorize the Colorado Commission on Criminal and Juvenile Justice (CCJJ) was postponed indefinitely on May 7, 2023. Therefore, with the sunset of the Commission, all activities of the CCJJ ceased on June 30, 2023.

No further monitoring of CCJJ recommendations will occur.

2013 - 2022 UPDATE

Status unknown.

2012 UPDATE

This recommendation requires statutory changes to be implemented.

Description

Eliminate non-alcohol related Driving Under Revocation (DUR), Driving Under Suspension (DUS) and Driving Under Denial (DUD) as a major offense for consideration by the DMV as a predicate offense to classification as a Habitual Traffic Offender (HTO). Eliminate mandatory jail sentences for non-alcohol related DUR, DUS and DUD while still retaining them as discretionary (see C.R.S. 42-2-202).
