2013 UPDATE

Reports regarding the impacts of House Bill 2010-1352 were completed between 2012 and 2013 by the Division of Criminal Justice, Office of Research and Statistics (These reports are available at ors.colorado.gov/ors-reports.)

2012 ACTION/IMPLEMENTATION

This recommendation was implemented with the passing of HB 10-1352. However, rather than any amount of concentrate, as recommended by the Commission, the final HB 10-1352 specifies three ounces or less of concentrate be a class 1 misdemeanor rather than a class 5 felony and that more than 3 ounces of concentrate is a class 6 felony.

Description

The possession of any amount of marijuana concentrate shall be decreased from a class 5 felony to a class 1 misdemeanor.
