Actions/Updates

2023 UPDATE (JUNE)

During the FY 2023 Legislative Session, Senate Bill 2023-158 to reauthorize the Colorado Commission on Criminal and Juvenile Justice (CCJJ) was postponed indefinitely on May 7, 2023. Therefore, with the sunset of the Commission, all activities of the CCJJ ceased on June 30, 2023.

No further monitoring of CCJJ recommendations will occur.

2016 UPDATE

Implementation is ongoing.

2013 UPDATE

For Calendar Year 2013, the DCJ/OCC has coordinated several classroom trainings regarding sex offender supervision and the lifetime supervision act. Board members and board staff are invited to these 3-day classroom trainings. The DCJ will work with the CACCB to coordinate a presentation by the SOMB regarding the lifetime supervision act.

Description

The Office of Community Corrections in the Division of Criminal Justice in collaboration with the SOMB shall work with the CACCB* and the GCCAC** on training for community corrections board members regarding the lifetime supervision act and sex offender supervision.

Discussion

Community corrections board members are especially cautious about accepting sex offenders into community corrections programs. Training to address the standards and specifics of treatment and supervision of sex offenders could enhance understanding and inform the evaluation of sex offender application for community corrections programs.
