# Actions/Updates

## **2023 UPDATE (JUNE)**

During the FY 2023 Legislative Session, Senate Bill 2023-158 to reauthorize the Colorado Commission on Criminal and Juvenile Justice (CCJJ) was postponed indefinitely on May 7, 2023. Therefore, with the sunset of the Commission, all activities of the CCJJ ceased on June 30, 2023.

No further monitoring of CCJJ recommendations will occur.

## **2013-2022 ACTION TO DATE**

Implementation unknown.

## **2012 ACTION TO DATE**

Requires action by the Staff of the Colorado Department of Corrections within the Sex Offender Treatment and Monitoring Program.

### Description

The State Board of Parole and treatment staff of the Department of Corrections' Sex Offender Treatment and Monitoring Program should develop a regular system of feedback when sex offenders who meet SOMB criteria are denied parole.

The intent is to increase the communication between parole board members and treatment staff, while avoiding the establishment of specific benchmarks for release.
