Welcome, Agenda	
Maureen Cain, All	In the absence of Michael Dougherty (Working Group Leader), Maureen Cain led the meeting, welcomed members, and outlined the meeting agenda.

Additional Listening Session	
& Meeting Schedule <i>Maureen Cain, All</i>	Maureen proposed hosting another Working Group listening session, as she was aware of additional stakeholders who were interested. Members also thought it was important to reach out to stakeholders who were unable to participate in the prior two listening sessions in June and invite them to this new session.

Damien will contact additional stakeholders	The group decided to schedule a listening session on July 27, 2021, tentatively, from 12pm – 6pm. Damien Angel, Staff agreed to coordinate with the Working Group members to acquire contacts and send invitations to stakeholders.
	Maureen stated that the Working Group should begin to return to its bimonthly meeting schedule to accommodate the additional material to be generated by the Study Group. Members concurred with an increase in meeting frequency and agreed to meet every other Tuesday from 2pm-5pm starting August 10, 2021.

Overview of Parole	
in Colorado	Christie provided a brief overview of function and structure of parole in
Christie Donner	Colorado, including how parole sentences, earned and good time computations, and the significant dates in a prison sentence related to parole (Parole Eligibility Date, Mandatory Release Date, etc.). The information in this presentation was distributed as a memo to the Working Group members via email for further review.
	Following Christie's overview, the group members agreed that the current parole processes do not align with the wishes stated by stakeholders during listening sessions for more simple and comprehensible sentences. Members agreed that they would most likely draft a recommendation that reflected more "truth in sentencing" that focused on increased clarity regarding the timing of parole eligibility and the length of parole periods. The group also agreed that this approach would eliminate discretionary release and, eventually, the Parole Board ( <i>Note: This change would not be retroactive and,</i> <i>therefore, previously sentenced inmates would still qualify for discretionary</i> <i>release</i> ).
	Christie stated that, while she was supportive of a truth-in-sentencing model, a model of this type would be more rigid than the current system. Dan and Tom agreed, but stated that the stakeholder feedback they received indicated that additional sentence rigidity was more than balanced by the added benefits of
