- *Substance abuse*



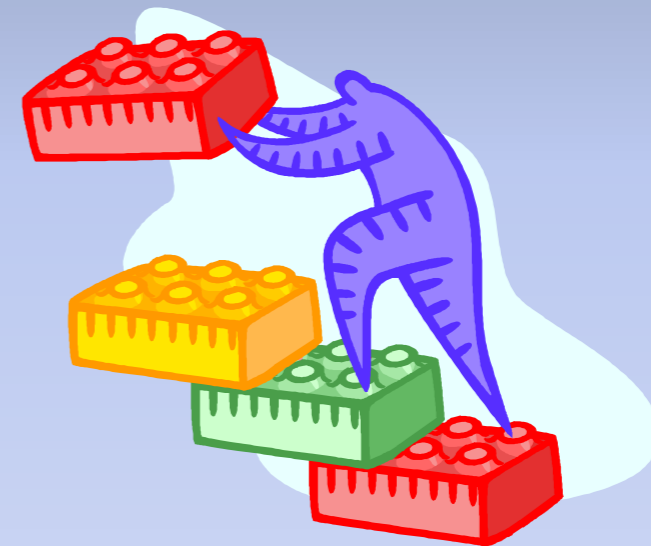
