Reentry Task Force: Conditions Working Group

PROCESS

- Define the purposes of conditions.
 - Discourage anti-social behavior.
 - Encourage pro-social behavior.
 - Maintain the necessary level of control.

- Review of parole, probation and community corrections conditions.
 - Are individual conditions fulfilling a defined purpose?
 - Are individual conditions presently problematic?
 - Are individual conditions resulting in a disproportionate number of technical violations?
 - Evaluating conditions in terms of evidence-based practices and research.

- Association. 17-2-201(5)(f)(I)(F).
- Testing frequency. 17-2-201(5.5)(a) & 17-2-201(5.5)(c) (I)
- Refusal. 17-2-201(5.5)(e).
