WHY are we creating ISE? WHAT are we trying to solve? HOW will we do it?

WHY are we creating ISE?

Create, access, and move data along the **continuum of the criminal justice system** for the purposes of enhancing and improving public safety and offender outcomes as well as making government more efficient.

WHAT are we trying to solve?

- Initially, provide a person-centric view of municipal courts, jail custody and booking images, and community corrections data.
- Create a 'system of insight' so that we can be disciplined to pick programs that work, match offenders with appropriate programming and sentencing, support evidenced-based decision making, and measure the true costs to the offender, agencies and the community.


HOW will we do it?

GOVERNANCE

Provides a mutually agreed upon framework that guides the design, development, implementation, management and sustainability for a sharing environment among participating agencies.

Criminal Justice Standards & Interoperability

SIMPLY PUT,

Criminal Justice IS Standards were created to provide a common approach to sharing electronic information among tribal, territorial, local, state, and Federal organizations. Standards help to provide a common framework (*how we are going to share and how to assure with security and privacy*)

AND a language to exchange information (*what we are going to share with semantic equivalency*).

Communications & Partnerships

While many agency leaders and public officials acknowledge the importance of partnerships, many are cautious of collaboration due to fears of losing control, responsibility, resources, or identity.

Information sharing is one area where the criminal justice system can attain quick and sustainable improvements through a formally structured and wellcoordinated governance and strategic framework.
