Disapprove: When the total of "B" votes is ≈ 51%.

Recommendation
Supermajority Threshold
Approve: When the total of "A" and "B" votes is ≈ 66%.

^ A majority threshold vote to assign an interim Vice-Chair of the Commission. Members voted to assign the DCJ Director to the position of CCJJ Vice-Chair in the interim from October until after the upcoming 2018 elections when new Executive Branch appointments are made. The DCJ Director is designated in statute as an *ex-officio*, non-voting member of the Commission; however, Commission members also granted voting privileges on Commission matters to the DCJ Director during this interim assignment period.
