


#### Total Crime Rate Change in USA, 2019 to 2020 (FBI)

# Colorado Crime Rate Change, 2019 to 2021







# Violent Crime Rates (CBI)




# Violent Crime Rate Change, 2019-2021





# Colorado Homicide Rate Change, 2019 to 2021








# Aggravated Assault Rates


# Aggravated Assault Using Firearm



# Property Crime Rate Change, 2019-2021





## Motor Vehicle Theft Rate Change 2019 to 2021





# **Burglary Location Type**




Commercial burglaries accounted for 20% of all burglaries in 2016 and rose to 30% in 2021




### Identity Theft Rate








#### Percent Change in District Court Criminal Filings FY 2020 to FY 2021





# Active Probation Population




#### Jail Past Year Average Daily Population

#### Jail Suicide Rate






#### Prison Suicide Rate 2000-2019




# Parole Releases by Type


#### Adult Parole Population

#### **Community Corrections Population**


