

The Brain Injury Alliance of Colorado (BIAC) is the go-to resource in Colorado for survivors of an acquired brain injury (i.e. traumatic brain injury, concussion, stroke, anoxia, etc.), their loved-ones, and providers. BIAC contracts with MINDSOURCE within the Colorado Department of Human Services to provide statewide services, such as resources, education, and guidance, for life after brain injury.
