

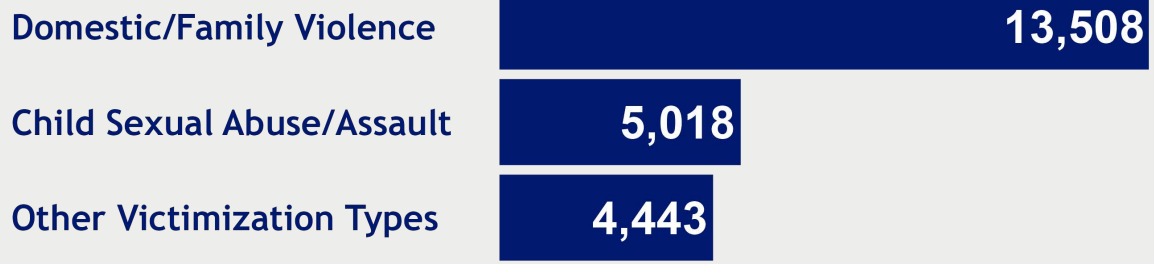
# Federal Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) FACES 45% BUDGET CUTS
