Position Summary:

The position of Wildland Crew Member requires extensive training in responding to, combating, extinguishing, preventing fires and performing rescue work. The individual will be required to learn and participate in the performance of tasks in emergency situations, which may require strenuous exertion in difficult terrain and inclement weather. The job requires the individual to complete a basic training program, learn all streets, trails, fire roads and water supply resources in the District and operate fire/rescue apparatus under emergency situations in adverse weather and traffic conditions. The Wildland Crew Member will also help procure and maintain wildland equipment, supplies, and apparatus.

Position Qualifications:

All candidates must meet *all* of the following minimum qualifications in order to be considered for the position:

General Requirements of Eligibility

- Must be of good moral character
- Must be in excellent physical condition and be able to successfully pass all physical assessments.
- Must be a minimum of eighteen (18) years of age.
- Must possess a valid Drivers' License.
- Must provide proof of automobile insurance as required by law.
- Must have clean driving record
- Must complete and submit a Mountain View Fire Rescue Application along with all other required documentation per Application.
