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DFPC's New Firefighter Certification and Testing System

Denver — February 5, 2016 — The Colorado Division of Fire Prevention and Control (DFPC) has deployed a new cloud-based Record Management System (RMS) for Firefighter certification and testing. The new system will go live **February 9, 2016**.

The new RMS will eventually replace all the paper-based scantron system and provides DFPC staff, Agency Training Officers, and Firefighters with an integrated, state-of-the-art technology for certification management. Among the important capabilities enabled by the new system is the ability for Training Officers to access their Firefighters testing records, certifications and download them as needed. The RMS will allow the Training Officer access to all of their assigned personnel's certification records, allow them to update their current roster, schedule certification exams, schedule practical exams and view certification progress. The Training Officer will also have the ability to instantly print new certificates when needed.

The RMS includes reminder capabilities for expiring certifications; a valid email address is needed for access to the system. Email reminders will be sent to the Firefighters and their Training Officers 90 days before expiration. Additionally, invoices will now be automatically generated for each exam and renewal requested through the RMS. Invoices will be processed once a week and sent to the responsible agency.
