### **Presentation Selection Process**

The CFFA Planning Committee will review each of the submitted proposals. Proposals shall be selected based on the value to the attendees, appropriateness to the topic indicated, financial impact to the CFFA and topic relevance. Each submitter will be notified as to the status of their submittal no later than June 20, 2016. All decisions made by the CFFA Planning Committee are final.
