- 2:25 - 2:45** **Legislative Update - *CSSRC Staff and Board Members***
- The bill (HB22-1275) to continue the CSSRC Advisory Board unanimously passed the House Education Committee and went to Appropriations (even though there is no fiscal note). A HUGE thank you to Chris Wilderman who withstood two hours of testimony on other bills before his wonderful three-minute testimony supporting the Advisory Board. Thank you, Chris!
 - The CDPS Decision Item by the 2022 Legislature to secure the CSSRC budget continues to move forward in the legislature.
 - The additional good news is that the proposal is now to fund the CSSRC with General Funds instead of the MJ Tax Cash Fund. This will be much more secure and not require a recurring Decision Item.
 - If passed, at least two of the three regional training consultants can be hired. Some funding will be saved for the recurring subscription cost of the online threat assessment system as we would prefer not to charge school districts for using this service.

 - SB22-1120 School Security Disbursement Program
 - HB22-1274 Interagency Working Group on School Safety
