## Safe2Tell 2018-2019 statewide data:

- 19,861 actionable tips
- 3668 suicide tips, 2164 drug tips, 1871 bullying tips

## The presentation emphasized 5 main ideas:

- 1. Students know safety and mental health concerns about their peers before adults.
- 2. As part of a healthy community, students have a duty to inform others about safety concerns.
- 3. As a first step, students should always try to talk to a trusted adult.
- 4. If that's too hard, or it's after school hours, Safe2Tell is a backup plan.
- 5. Safe2Tell is anonymous to encourage students to report safety concerns.

## What do parents need to know about Safe2Tell?

- Tips can be submitted by calling 1-877-542-7233, at <a href="www.safe2tell.org">www.safe2tell.org</a>, or on the Google Play and Apple Store Apps.
- Parents can make a report themselves as well as with/on behalf of their child(ren).
- After submitting a report, a Safe2Tell dispatcher will always respond with their name and ask follow-up questions. <u>Please wait</u> and engage in a conversation with Safe2Tell.
- Safe2Tell relays concerns to local law enforcement and schools. Safe2Tell itself does not investigate tips.
- If you and/or your child(ren) have a mobile device, add the Safe2Tell app to it.

## What Safe2Tell Can/Cannot Do For You:

- Safe2Tell does not notify the Reporting Party of the report outcome. All outcome information is private and autonomous to Safe2Tell.
- If you have previously reported the situation to your school staff and are not satisfied with the outcome, Safe2Tell cannot enforce a different outcome. Please find the process within your school district for escalating these concerns.
- Safe2Tell is not a resource for keeping a "record" of your school or child's history.
- Safe2Tell accepts tips related to young adults at a location unknown to you, other states, and other countries. Please use Community at Large as the school/location.
