SCHOOL SAFETY Partnership Opportunity

Surveys and data reports to help school or district teams identify strengths and areas of need related to the systems that support school safety, culture, and climate.

WHO WE CAN SUPPORT

Forty school- or districtbased multidisciplinary teams in Colorado. Partners will be accepted on a rolling basis.

LENGTH OF PROJECT

Partners can receive up to two years of support, depending on when they enter the project.
