How to Register for this Event on the CO Train System

Registration for this Event is on the CO Train System: There are 2 steps required in this registration process: (1) creating your learner account, and (2) registering for the training. This process will take approximately 5-10 minutes. The CO Train System works best with Internet Explorer and will not work with Firefox.

1. Go to www.CO.train.org; click "Create Account" button if you are a new user. If you are a returning user, proceed to step 5.
2. On the following page, read the TRAIN policies and agree to these policies before clicking "Next".
3. Fill out all necessary information on each of the subsequent pages. Click "Next" to continue.
4. Once your Learner's account is set up, click "Continue" to register for the training.
5. Search for this event by Course ID: 1051817. Click on the title of the course, "Traumatized Youth and How Schools Can Assist".
6. Click on the Registration tab. Select the location of the course you wish to attend (Thornton) and click "Register".
