11:20 - 11:50	Training and Data Conversation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What data does each agency collect? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ CDE <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Collects a variety of legislatively mandated data ■ Trainings are often attached to grants and then evaluated within the grants ■ Some trainings are open to the public and others just to grantees ■ There is no standardized evaluation of their trainings ■ Recently they have created a list of their school safety, mental health or SEL trainings. 		<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Safe2Tell<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Must provide training to all K-12 schools in Colorado.■ Also train law enforcement officers■ SRO training. It will be at the CASRO Conference next year■ Communication centers folks■ Safe2Tell ambassadors may choose to train peers on Safe2Tell■ Evaluated by pre-post surveys to check baseline knowledge of the program. What other questions.■ They collect data on what regions they have trained○ CDHS<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Nothing specific in law that requires■ School officials need to take mandatory reporting training and CDHS offers that but that training happens throughout.<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Not sure right now if there is any evaluation associated with mandatory reporting training although GR doesn't think so as● Maybe ask CDE about policies related to mandatory reporting training.■ Data in general: yearly education report for DYS. includes recidivism data.■ For youth in foster care, collect data on Grad rates and all youth must have child welfare education liaisons so there may be training associated with that.■ Trying to get a data sharing agreement with CDE to share data re: CMP○ BHA<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Training related to Project AWARE which CDE has data on. Evaluation of the trainings is conducted and aligned with SAMHSA requirements.■ I Matter just completed an evaluation<ul style="list-style-type: none">● If evaluation isn't in the bill, people aren't doing it.■ Staff from schools can take online mental health online courses on OwnPath.<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Not sure about evaluation but sure there is something.■ Suzy Morris HB24-1406 - School based mental health support program.<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Program evaluation is required but don't yet have an evaluation.

The specialists provide trainings to schools but I am not sure how they are evaluated. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Mental Health First Aid is a training they may provide and this has its own evaluation ● Also has trainings with mental health providers but not sure about the evaluation. ○ CDHE <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Does not provide any training re: school safety. ■ Clery Act info if interested: https://crsreports.congress.gov/product/pdf/IF/IF12597 - report crime on campuses. ■ Interested in supporting campuses ■ Also interested related to concurrent enrollment where sometimes HS kids travel to college campuses and there may be an opportunity to partner there. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Training would happen through CDE if there are requirements. ■ One element regarding college safety DHE is a pass through for is sexual misconduct/Title IX - our Executive Director appoints members of a committee that provides guidance/recommendations to colleges/universities on complying with Title IX/sexual misconduct federal guidelines - also, we post links on policies and training colleges provide regarding sexual misconduct: https://cdhe.colorado.gov/educators/administration/title-ix-student-protections-against-gender-discrimination/sexual ● How many staff members are involved in those collections? ● Where do we think the SSWG should start with data collection? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Suggest that we note whether trainings/programs are being evaluated ○ If no evaluation is happening, at least link the legislative report or any other information that might summarize how the program is doing.
