Stephanie Peyton Tuthill - age 24

Robbed, raped and killed by Donta T. Paige
February 24, 1999

Paige was transferred to Colorado from Maryland to participate in a halfway house treatment program. His transfer to Colorado occurred without any notice to Colorado. Paige walked away from the program before he even began it.

Peyton Tuthill

Peyton Tuthill, a 24-year-old graduate student and resident of Florida, was attending college in Colorado. She was the president of her sorority, an environmentalist, a volunteer for the American Cancer Society and Habitat for Humanity. She volunteered at a shelter for abused women.

On 02/24/1999, Peyton had a job interview. She returned to her apartment to find it had been burglarized and that the burglar was still there.

Following the death of her daughter, Pat Tuthill has been referred to as an "outspoken" activist and advocate of the Interstate Compact for Adult Offender Supervision, traveling the nation and visiting with state policy makers.
